



## Re-Opening Plan for the Fort Nelson Thrift Shop

### Handling Donations

A separate area has been created for dropping of donations.

Clothing donations will remain untouched for 2 days.

Non-clothing donations will remain untouched for 3 days.

All volunteers handling donations will be provided PPE consisting of masks, gloves, gowns, and hand sanitizer.

Once donations have been sorted and gone into the main area, the drop-off area will be cleaned in preparation for the next delivery.

### Retail

A maximum of 10 customers will be allowed in the store at one time.

A Hand Sanitizing Station will be installed at the door which all customers will be required to use before entering the store

On anticipated high traffic days (IE: Bag Sales and days as anticipated by the store supervisor) a volunteer will man the door to ensure maximum numbers and hand sanitization is adhered to

On non-high traffic days the door handles will be wiped down regularly

Aisles will be designated one-way and clearly marked with a maximum of 2 people allowed in each aisle at one time

At the end of each shift all counters and surfaces will be wiped down
